## CHRISTMAS GIVING TREE

Archangel Council #7429, Knights of Columbus and the St. Vincent de Paul Society (SVDP) in conjunction with the Parish Community of St. Simon Stock, are, once again, sponsoring a Christmas Giving Tree. We do this in an attempt to insure as many in our community as possible may be able to share in the blessings of the Christmas Season.

We have sent letters to all the schools in our area asking them to distribute white index cards to families in need. Each child has been asked to request a present. We ask them to limit the cost of the present to around \$40. You will see the first name and the sex of the child along with a control number. The St. Vincent de Paul Society is doing the same with their clients. We hope to give a gift to every child in the family from infant to the end of elementary school.

This year we are also adopting **Greta's House** and **Veteran's Haven**. Both of these organizations deal with adults in need of help. Veteran's Haven deals with veterans who are in need of help.

On the weekend of Nov. 30/ Dec.1 cards will be placed on the bulletin boards at the entrances to the church. Most of the **white** cards will have the first name and sex of a child along with a specific request. Some will have the name and sex of a child without a specific request. We will also post some **green** cards with request from **Greta's House**. For **Veteran's Haven**, we request gift cards from various stores. In this manner the veterans can buy what they need. We will post some **yellow** index cards representing **senior citizens**.

Please come to the bulletin boards, select a card for the person for whom you wish to obtain a gift and **attach the index card to the outside of the wrapped gift and return it on the weekend of Dec. 14/15. We need to collect the gifts by this date in order to insure proper delivery. Each family will also receive a food basket.**

If you would like to make a monetary contribution, we can turn it into a gift. Please make checks payable to "**Archangel Council #7429**". And place it into an envelope marked "**Giving Tree**" and drop it into the collection basket. We thank you in advance for your generosity.

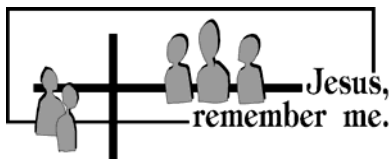

## READINGS FOR THIS SUNDAY OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE



### First Reading: 2 Samuel 5:1-3

Samuel describes how all the tribes of Israel went to David in Hebron and said they were his bone and his flesh and it was he who led them back to Israel. The Lord told David he would be a shepherd to His people. David made an agreement with the elders and was anointed king.

### Second Reading: Colossians 1:12-20

Paul explains to the Colossians that God has made them fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light and that through the Son we have redemption and forgiveness of sin. He describes Jesus as the image of the invisible God, the head of the church and in Him all things hold together.

### Gospel: Luke 23:35-43

Jesus is mocked by the crowd as he hung on the cross. Above him was an inscription that read "This is the king of the Jews." One of the men being crucified with Jesus tells Him to save them and Himself, while the other asks that he be remembered when Jesus is in his kingdom. Jesus said in reply, "Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

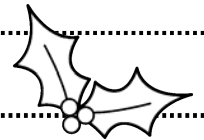
