Bishop Sullivan to Celebrate 2nd Annual Diocesan Respect Life Mass

Wednesday, January 22, 12:05 pm, Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, 642 Market Street, Camden. On the 41st anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court Decision, we will gather as a diocese to pray for an end to abortion and for a greater respect for all life.
