Quiet, her posture drawn close within herself, steeling herself for the dreaded talk, she reveals to a stranger across the office desk that she and her husband are stressed financially and need help and food. Her husband stays in the hall initially until asked to join us. His eyes stare into nothingness and he is stoically silent. He's retired and she's ill. They're on disability and social security. They just barely manage to pay their bills as they have all their working life but they don't have money left for enough food for the month. They live outside our parish boundary and service area. We give them emergency bags of nonperishables, produce and bread. We look up the nearest food pantry to their home and give them the location and hours of operation. Then we change places at the desk.

Our couple is shown how to go to NJ211 online and click on Basic Needs and discover ways to get help for themselves for Food, Utility Assistance and other concerns. They take notes, make eye contact for the first time, inhale a visible breath, sit up straighter and show us what hope looks like in their face and eyes. Volunteer with us at our Food Pantry at 157 W. WHP and see hope happen. Come in or phone us at 856-767-7391 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays 11 AM - 3 PM. We look forward to meeting you!
