## READINGS FOR THIS SUNDAY TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



### First Reading: Zechariah 12:10-11, 13:1

Zechariah describes the mourning that will occur over Jesus' crucifixion. The people of Jerusalem will mourn him as they would mourn an only son or a fallen king.

### Second Reading: Galatians 3:26-29

Paul reinforces that all those who accept Christ are equal in God's eyes. Man or woman, Jew or Greek, is unimportant in God's eyes if you have true faith in Jesus.

### Gospel: Luke 9:18-24

Jesus asks the disciples who they think he is. They reply that he is the Messiah. Jesus forbids them to tell this to others, and explains that first he must suffer, be put to death, and rise up on the third day. He explains to them that they also must be willing to suffer for his sake if they wish to be saved.

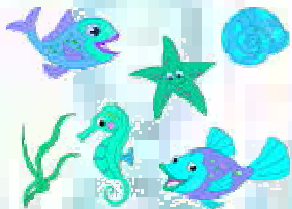

## Parish Bulletin Health Tips for June

This is the time of year when people begin to spend more time outside and in the sunshine. This however comes with certain risks, especially for over exposure to UV rays which can lead to skin cancer. The Center for Disease Control recommends these easy options for protection from UV radiation:

1. Stay in the shade as often as possible.
2. Wear clothing that covers your arms and legs when exposed to the sun for long periods of time.
3. Wear a wide brim hat.
4. Wear wrap around sunglasses.
5. Use sunscreen, SPF of 15 or higher is recommended.
6. Avoid indoor tanning.



### DID YOU KNOW . . .

- Protection from UV radiation is important all year round and that the sun can reach you on cloudy and hazy days as well as sunny days.
- UV rays can reflect off of surfaces such as water, cement, sand and snow.
- UV rays are strongest during the hours of 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and during late spring and early summer.

Most of all, enjoy your time outdoors. And remember to follow the above tips for yourself and your children. We know that children are often resistant to follow these tips, but you'll be doing them a great service in monitoring their time in the sun and being insistent on following the necessary precautions. And remember, providing a good example is the most effective way to ensure their practice of these helpful tips.
