READINGS FOR THIS SUNDAY SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



First Reading: Genesis 18:1-10a

The Lord appeared to Abraham, who saw three men standing near his tent. Sensing they were messengers, he hurriedly brought them food and water to refresh themselves. Upon leaving, the men told him that they would visit in a year, at which time his childless wife Sarah would have a son.

Second Reading: Colossians 1:24-28

Paul discusses the suffering Christ endured for his Church. He describes his willingness to also endure suffering in Jesus' name. Paul hopes that through his sacrifices, many people will become complete in Jesus.

Gospel: Luke 10:38-42

Jesus was welcomed into the home of a woman named Martha. She complained to Jesus that her sister Mary sat listening to him instead of helping with the tasks of entertaining. Jesus told Martha that her sister had chosen the more important task, and should be allowed to listen.

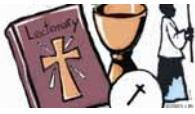

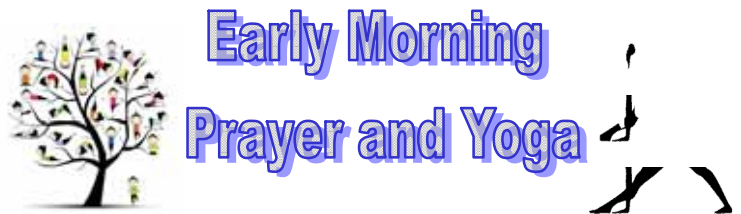

VITALITY Health Tips

Staying hydrated during the summer is sometimes quite the challenge. Water is the best for hydrating yet it can become bland or boring. Flavored water is becoming all the rage. There are simple recipes for making your own flavored waters with fresh and nutritious ingredients you probably already have in your kitchen. You should use fresh ingredients every 24-48 hours. No lugging bottles of sugary drinks from the store. <http://vitality.camdendiocese.org/parish-nurse/> Just a little planning can revitalize your health and your wallet.

Tips for getting started:

- Filtered/spring water - you can use the filtered water from your fridge.
- Glass pitcher or jars – plastic pitcher may allow the ingredients to leach into the pitcher instead of the water
- Plan ahead – all of these waters suggest letting the mixture sit for a few hours
- Experiment – don't be afraid to put some herbs in your water, they add to the flavor, not the calories
- Fresh – the fruit and vegetables need to be fresh or frozen for the max nutrients
- Muddle – crushing some of the harder fruits and herbs releases the flavor.
- Clean – remember to wash everything first before putting it in the pitcher

Some basic recipes:

- Slice up citrus fruit, lemons, limes, oranges and grapefruit. Wash them first to remove any waxy residue
- Cucumbers and mint are a fresh combination with anti-inflammatory properties
- Berries of all kinds, just muddle before adding, they are high in antioxidants
- Melons and pineapple cubed with a bit of grated ginger
- Sliced apples and/or pears with cinnamon
- Bananas are not the best choice
