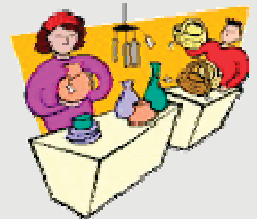

St. Simon Stock Conference of St. Vincent de Paul Society



On May 11, 2017, SVdP received this email which is printed with permission.

“Today with the help of two of my friends I was able to deliver a carload of clothing, toys, bottles, some baby formula, high chair and car seat to Good Counsel Home [in Riverside] for girls, alone, pregnant with no place to go. They were so very excited to receive these items. At present time they have eight girls at the home. They told us that the girls can stay there as long as two years. They learn how to take care of their babies, some type of education that will enable them to be able to take care of themselves when they leave. Sister told me that the girls know that if they need anything after they leave they can always come back to Good Counsel for help. Sometimes they have so many girls that they have to utilize the staff’s working area to provide shelter and care for them.

For those who do not know, St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store supplied me with six large bags of clothing to go with the clothing I had collected myself...We really only were thinking about the babies but the Sister in charge said they can always use clothing for the girls also. She told me if they have an abundance of clothing and donations that they have other Good Counsel Homes that they share the extras.

I cannot express the wonderful feeling it was for me to be able to provide so much to a group who have so little or next to nothing. I cannot imagine myself or my daughters or anyone I know to be in this situation. I just want to thank St. Vincent de Paul Society and Thrift Store for their generosity.”
